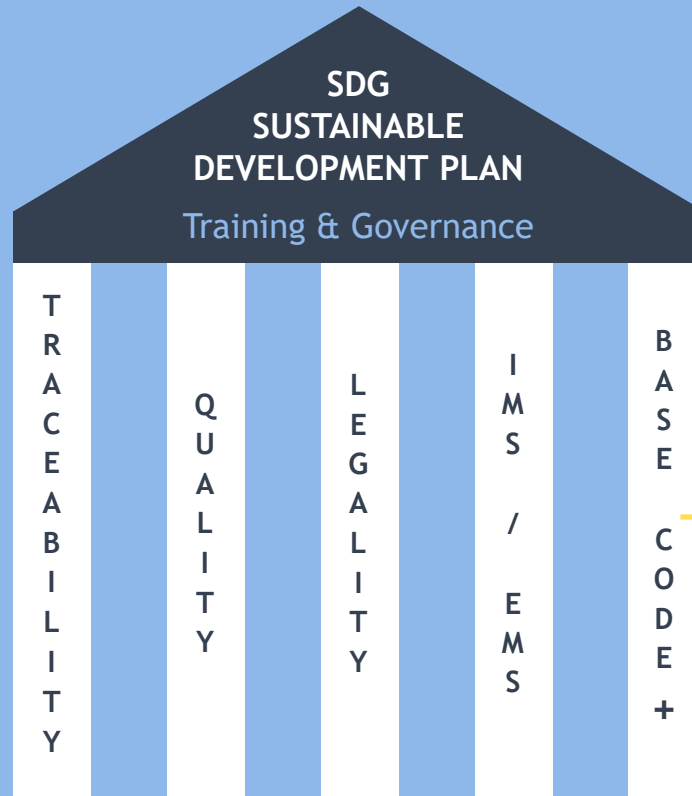

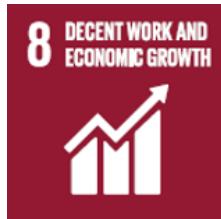

SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS

Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all

OUR TARGETS

1. Operate a preferential supplier list with access to preferential payment terms and pre-financing through a credit facility
2. Over the next 5 years, double our business with our selected suppliers and bring economic growth and opportunity to the communities involved in the production of our seafood
3. Ensuring no further expansion in land base to grow prawns - we will target the use of previous redundant ponds for expansion

OUR TARGETS

1. Engage with WISE (Wilberforce Institute for the Study of Slavery and Emancipation) to risk assess and conduct a desktop review of our supply chain
2. Following discussions with ISSARA, take part in worker's voice schemes by collaborating with our Indonesian supplier and trade union
3. Work with local NGOs for mutual benefit of community stakeholders and suppliers

UN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

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FISHMEAL & FISHERIES

Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development

OUR TARGETS

1. Through industry collaboration, educate and influence our feed supply chains to improve sustainable yield through environmental consideration. Our target is 100% from MSC or FIP fisheries in our direct supply chains
2. Improve traceability in supply chains through Marin Trust (formerly known as the IFFO RS Standard and Version 2.0 Standard) chain of Custody certification
3. Work with suppliers to support alternative protein development
4. Stakeholder engagement to develop new Fishery improvement programs or certification

UN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS



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DAMAGE TO THE ENVIRONMENT

Protect, restore and promote sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, and halt and reverse land degradation and halt biodiversity loss

OUR TARGETS

1. Soya from low risk or zero deforestation. Work with Soy Transparency Coalition to support this aim
2. Raise \$50,000 annually for the Borneo orangutan and forestry management in Kalimantan
3. Partner with Indonesian supplier and Way Kambas National park to plant 2.5m mangroves saplings annually

SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS - FAIRTRADE

One of our key preferred suppliers, CPB, is developing a Fairtrade program with Blueyou Consulting LTD For shrimp that is certified as Fair Trade by Fair Trade USA.

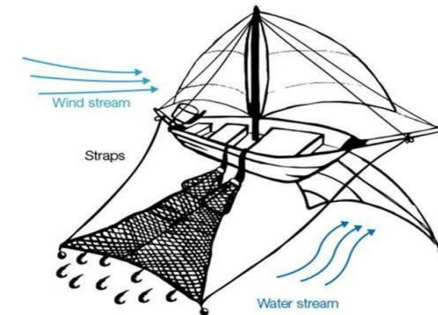
Farmer premium is used to fund community development, schooling and health services projects for the farmers, field staff, factory employees and their communities
